Correspondence	Following an enquiry from a Parishioner the Council considered the possibility of installing a textile recycling bank and decided that there was not sufficient need for it at this time. The reasons are that many charities deliver recycling bags to homes in the parish, some supermarkets have bins and there are facilities at the household waste sites.  The parishioner also suggested that the council might apply to the Vale Lottery for project funding. It appears that only registered charities are eligible to apply  Play Around the Parishes – Council agreed not to participate.  Open Spaces Society request for a donation – Council agreed not to donate.
