Current Status

- Aylesbury Vale District Council has just published its DRAFT VALE OF AYLESBURY LOCAL PLAN (VALP) <u>http://www.aylesburyvaledc.gov.uk/vale-aylesbury-local-plan-draft-plan</u>
- Their latest plan requires us to build more houses in Edlesborough than we originally shared with you at our meetings in January, and fewer houses in Dagnall & Northall.
- Our plan has to contain this new number as a minimum requirement
- Teams of parishioners have been working on some options and we now need your input

How to participate?

- Attend any, but at least one, of the meetings listed. The information will be the same at each meeting
- There are no formal presentations we invite you to just drop-in during the times listed
- Look at the information shown on display boards and feel free to ask questions
- Finally, give us your feedback to help us prepare our Draft Plan

What happens next?

- We have to prepare and submit a formal Draft Plan with recommendations for our parish.
- This Draft Plan will then be shared for wider consultation. This will also engage businesses, landowners and other interested parties for feedback.
- Based on that feedback we will produce the Final Plan that will go to AVDC, a Government Inspector and then you will get to vote to approve or reject the plan

Without a plan that has the support of our parishioners, other people will make the decisions for us!
