The changes in the collection of bins will be commenced throughout the District from June 2012. Information leaflets will in due course be affixed to the existing bins giving information as to when this will affect Edlesborough, Dagnall and Northall. Households are being encouraged to sign up and take advantage of the new optional garden waste service which will be a fortnightly kerbside service operating between February and November collecting all grass cuttings, twigs and small branches, weeds and hedge trimmings in a new 240-litre brown wheeled bin. The annual cost to households will be £36. Information leaflets have been place at the Surgery in Cow Lane and Edlesborough Stores & Post Office.
