Edlesborough Green Play Area & Roundabout

In March work commenced on the upgrading of the original Edlesborough Green play area surface, with the central fence being removed and the bark being replaced with safety matting & grass seed to match the later extension to the area.

It was anticipated that the older section of the play area would be closed for six - eight weeks due to health & safety reasons & to allow time for the new grass seed to germinate.

However due to children disregarding the signs and taped off play equipment the play area will now unfortunately remain closed for a longer period of time. Security fencing will also be erected at an additional expense to EPC.
