The Chairman welcomed those in attendance.

Thames Valley Police Report

PCSO Jackie Dodson reported that there has been an unusually high number of vehicle crimes for the area; with thefts from 13 vehicles over the past year. Some offenders have been apprehended along with £100's of recovered equipment. TVP ask that owners be more security conscious and ensure they mark their tools with permanent marker pen to enable the police to return them.

Parishioners' Questions

The Chairman invited the Parishioners to raise any questions or concerns.

- Slicketts Lane
 - Parishioners are increasingly concerned about the narrowness of the road due to the slippage of the banks and damage being caused by HGV's using the road. In many parts the road is now so narrow that there are no safe places for pedestrians to stand whilst vehicles pass.
 - Action: Following County Cllr Davies' suggestion that the issue with the banks could be addressed later in the year, when the Ford Road is resurfaced, the clerk will write to the Local Area Technician requesting this.
- Main Road South road sign A parishioner reported that the sign is damaged. *Action: The clerk will report this to AVDC for repair.*
- Taskers row streetlight panel

 A parishioner reported that the panel at the bottom of the streetlight in Taskers Row was loose.

 Action: Clerk will ask DP to attend to this and make it safe.
