



Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting for Edlesborough

held on Thursday 20th April 2017

at Edlesborough Memorial Hall commencing at 7.30pm

The Chairman welcomed those in attendance.

Thames Valley Police Report

PCSO Jackie Dodson reported the following crime figures:

- Burglary – 15 in total, 11 in Edlesborough, 1 in Northall, and 3 in Dagnall,
- 4 x Burglary dwellings in Edlesborough have had 2 suspects charged with the offences I believe they are awaiting trial for these.
- Burglary other - Edlesborough 9.
- Criminal Damage - Edlesborough 5, Northall 2.
- Theft - Edlesborough 5, Dagnall 3.
- Theft of Motor vehicle - Edlesborough 3, Dagnall 1.
- Theft from Motor Vehicle - Edlesborough 7, Dagnall 2,
- Vehicle Interference - Edlesborough 3, Northall 1, and Dagnall 1.
- Numerous traffic offences, of which 35 x driving offences were dealt with for the whole parish.
- 1 x Possession with intent to supply class A - Suspect arrested and charged, awaiting trial next month.
- 2 x Possession of a class b drug – 1 x Fined at court, 1 x cannabis street warning

Council & PCSO Dodson discussed the recent anti-social behaviour on Edlesborough Village Green. Cllr Wilkinson reported that youths have also been gathering in the Cow Lane Surgery car park late at night. PCSO Dodson will increase patrols of these locations.

The Minutes of the previous Meeting

The Minutes of the previous Annual Parish Meeting held on 21st April 2016 were agreed and signed by the Chairman with no amendments.

Accounts

Cllr Nevard shared an end of year Balance Sheet with the full council. Council had budgeted for a small surplus in the accounts this surplus has however come in at £33,000. This is due to the underspend in Devolved Services, parishioner donations, donations from the St Mary's Carnival, the Neighbourhood Plan Grant, the early payment from BCC for next years Devolved Services, and a refund on Streetlight energy costs
Currently EPC has £124,000 with £83,000 earmarked for ongoing projects.

Council agreed that this is a good outcome for the year. It was highlighted that whilst the Council have underspent in Devolved Services EPC are still working on catching up the on neglected over past years. The current payment from Bucks CC for Devolved Services currently does not cover EPC's expenditure on the works required.

Chairman's Report

The Chairman gave a 'PowerPoint' presentation of the Council's various activities during the year. This included:

- Bucks CC Devolved Services
- New Website
- Edlesborough Parish Neighbourhood Plan which was submitted to AVDC on 6th April 2017
- New Pavilion
- Defibrillators
- The refurbishment of the roundabout

Cllr Williams thanked the Cllrs, District & County Cllrs, PCSO Dodson, the Clerk and the many volunteers who aid the Parish Council throughout the year; including the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group and Villages Teams, EDaN Teams, Allotment Wardens, Charity Trustees and the parishioners who help to keep the village tidy.

Parishioners' Questions

The Chairman invited the Parishioners to raise any questions or concerns.

- A parishioner thanked EPC for the siding out, particularly between The Travellers Rest and Ivinghoe Way and at the Travellers Rest roundabouts.
- A parishioner requested that using Speedwatch from The Traveller's Rest towards Ivinghoe be considered especially since the recent fatality.
- A parishioner asked who the missing bollards on the Travellers Rest roundabouts should be reported to. The Clerk confirmed that these have been reported to Transport for Bucks but that they can be reported again. District Cllr Chris Poll advised that TfB are currently spending most of their money on potholes. It was also advised that if a notification is received re completed works in the Parish to check that TfB actually have completed the works as advised.
