

## Hedge Cutting in the Parish

Following guidance from the NFU, RSPB & RHS the parish council will not be carrying out any hedge cutting throughout the villages between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 31<sup>st</sup> July unless the hedge, tree or shrub overhangs a highway or any other road or footway to which the public has access so as to endanger or obstruct the passage of vehicles or pedestrians, or obstructs or interferes with the view of drivers or vehicles or the light from a public lamp, overhangs a highway so as to endanger or obstruct the passage of horse-riders.



This is with the exception of:

- The hedge which borders the Green alongside the High Street and Pebblemoor, this hedge will be cut following a thorough inspection for nesting birds.

Following a recent inspection EPC have instructed our contractor to cut “The Pastures Hedge” to ensure the footway is no longer obstructed.

- The “Pastures Hedge” borders properties on parts of The Green, Brownlow Avenue and Pebblemoor.
- The contractor will cut this hedge to a recommended height of 8ft on either the 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> July. Residents whose properties border the hedge have been notified.

The parish council asks parishioners to ensure that the planting around the boundaries of their properties does not cause a danger or inconvenience to others.
