Hiring Fees

- **■**Fees increased from £5.00 to £5.50 for regular users w.e.f. 1st January 2016
- **■Fees increased from £6.50 to £7.00 for Ad Hoc users w.e.f.** 1st January 2016
- •On the 1st October 2016 a new higher booking fee of £12 per hour was introduced for people living outside the villages of Edlesborough, Eaton Bray, Dagnall and Northall
- Lowest village hall hiring fees in area

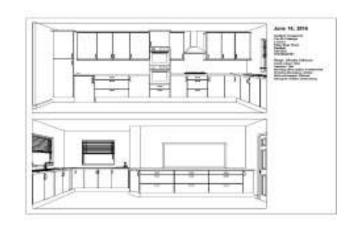
2016 was the first full year of 'Feed in Tariff' income and £1,235 was earned by the solar panel installation.

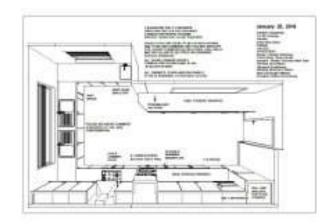
Village Hall Grounds

Grant application to AVDC Community Chest for £17,192 was approved in September 2016.

Grant application to WREN for £39,000 was declined.

Decision taken by Village Hall Committee to re-apply to WREN for reduced grant of approx. £36,000.

If successful likely date for completion will be September 2018.

4. Trustees Annual Report for 2016 AGM 2016 Barbecue/picnic/Fun Day



The AGM was held on Sunday the 12th June and was combined with a barbecue/picnic/fun day which proved to be very successful and was well attended by local residents. The event produced a small profit of £188.

Soft Play Equipment

The Soft Play Equipment has proved to be increasingly popular and contributed the sum of £410 an increase of 28% over 2015 in respect of hiring fees towards the hall's income.



Key Issues & Future Plans

- Continue driving Vision of making NVH one of "...the best for cleanliness, décor, equipment, facilities, safety - and value for money"
- Extension, refurbishment and modernisation of the kitchen to include new sink, cooker and fridge. The Committee is currently reapplying for a grant from WREN.
- Sensory garden in area on the south side of the hall.
