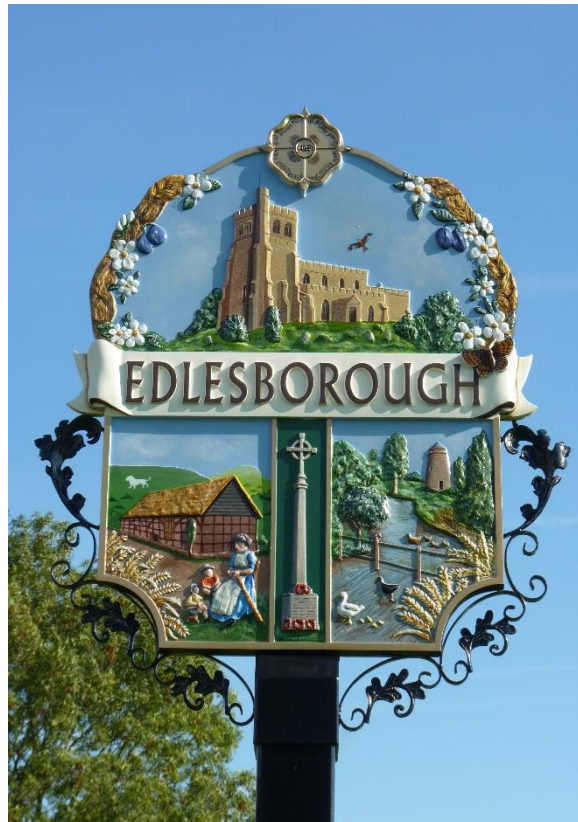

Referendum result

886 voted YES

115 voted NO

88% in favour

- ADDITIONAL STREET PAVING Rejected
- EXTRA HARD STANDING NEAR THE SURGERY -Trying to progress with AVDC
- PLAYGROUND UPGRADE – New surface
New gate
- PENSION FOR PENNY- Implemented

Other initiatives/activities in 2017/18

- Traffic Calming – Three projects identified - now under consideration
- Funding of the Community First Responder
- £20,000 'earmarked' funding for Dagnall Village Hall improvements
- Work to establish the appropriate legal status of parish allotments
- Work to reject the proposed Swallowfields development.
- Established better working relationships with sports clubs

- Replacing rotten planter sleepers with new wood-look plastic sleepers
- Continued to maintain plants in planters

- **TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT**

- B440 replaced A4146
- HGV limit delayed by yet another Freight Strategy from BCC
- Needs a new chairperson
- Needs a re-launch

- Work progressing to install Kitchen and Toilets
- Tower opening plans rejected by The CCT for safety reasons
