Home to School Transport Consultation 2018

County Councillor Anne Wight would like to draw your attention to the school bus consultation on the BCC website went live on 31st October and runs until 4 January, 2019.

Details of the consultation can be found on the BCC Website under the "Have your say" consultation link on the homepage.

Bucks CC have prepared a Draft Home to School Transport Policy to set out the proposed arrangements. This has been drafted in line with the Department for Education's statutory guidance.

There are three proposals they are seeking your views on:

- Changing how we provide school transport – greater integration of school bus services with public bus services
- Only providing free home to school transport to the nearest eligible school, withdrawing historic, non-statutory transport arrangements in Ivinghoe and Evreham (Iver)
- Introducing transport charges for students with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) aged 16+
