Luton Airport Expansion Consultation

78% increase in passenger numbers (mppa)48% increase in air traffic movements (ATMs)

<u>Assumption</u> Airlines will operate slightly larger planes at higher load factors than currently (i.e. more passengers per flight).

If that assumption is not realised; 78% increase in mppa = 78% increase in ATMs


Recommendation - There needs to be a limit on the number of ATMs as well as the number of passengers

CLAIM 2 Reduction in the population and area covered by the relevant noise contours due to the newer aircraft being quieter..

<u>Assumption</u> The noise improvements predicted for the newer generation aircraft will more than offset the additional ATMs.

Facts

- 1. The measured noise reductions for the newer aircraft (Airbus NEO and Boeing Max8) are not being fully realised.
- 2. Even if the improvements are fully realised, the improvements are principally on take-off (departure) not arrival. This will change the shape of the noise contours resulting in an extension of the extremities along the final approach flight paths (see example below).



Recommendation - There must be no extension of any of the existing noise contour boundaries
