Changes were made to the standard Terms and Conditions of Hire to reflect the risks identified in the risk assessment, requesting that, the necessary steps are carried out in the event of fire. A copy of the adopted notice would be attached to Booking forms for the Memorial Hall and copies sent to groups using the Pavilion. Additional smoke alarms would be fitted in both the Memorial Hall and Pavilion. Manager to check that Fire Exit signs are lit and to ensure all current signage is correct. The clerk will write to Clubs again regarding the arson risk if pavilion doors are left unlocked, as happened again recently.
