Minutes of the Ordinary meeting of the Edlesborough Parish Council held on Thursday 18th December 2008 at Edlesborough Memorial Hall

#### **Minutes of Previous Meeting**

The Minutes were approved and signed by the Vice Chairman as a true record

#### **Matters Arising from previous Minutes**

Cllr Cubbage had attended a recent Eaton Bray Parish Council meeting and he outlined some of the similarities and differences between the two councils. It was agreed that EPC could benefit from taking up one or two of the ideas including the 'Open Forum'

An 'Open Forum' item had been placed on the Agenda and would continue to be an Agenda item giving parishioners the opportunity to attend Parish Council meetings to discuss any matters of concern. Future Notice Board Agendas would include 'Open Forum' and this would be referred to in the next Focus article.

#### **Finance Reports:**

Financial reports for the period ended 30<sup>th</sup> November 2008 were presented to the Council. Full year forecast figures

had been updated. As the YTD expenditure on the Cemetery was so much more than budget, the Clerk was requested to itemize the Cemetery expenses and circulate the information to Councillors.

The Parish Council's Fixed Assets to be circulated to Councillors and put on next month's Agenda.

# **Budget/Precept**

It was unanimously agreed to request a Precept of £62,500.00. Full details of the budget would be prepared for the next meeting. Streetlight maintenance quotation received.

# **Traffic Calming**

Edlesborough: Clerk to chase up response requesting Training Lorries not to use Edlesborough High Street during School arriving/departing times

#### A4146 Waste Disposal Lorries

The Council were in receipt of information given by Bedfordshire Highways. As the M1 is now almost completed the Waste Recycling Depot has requested that lorries use the M1/A5 route. The appearance of waste disposal lorries will be carefully monitored throughout the Parish and names taken of companies that continue to use the A4146. A copy of the information received will be forwarded to County Councillor Avril Davies.

## **General Purposes Committee Report**

Councillors had been given copies of the draft GPC Minutes. It had been clarified that the electric cable between the Scout Hut and the Memorial Hall is protected by a sheath and the recent work carried out by Under 5's had not disturbed the cable.

Papers have been sent to the Land Registry for registration of The Green. Clerk to establish with Solicitors as to whether or not the remainder of The Green, which is already registered as Common Land, should also be included in the current Registration.

A site meeting will take place early in the New Year to discuss Footpath 3.

Council agreed to the addition of a further clause to the Conditions of Hire for the Memorial Hall as follows:

'The Hall key must be returned immediately after the event otherwise an additional charge may be incurred'

Clerk to advise Grass Cutting contractors regarding 2009 quotations.

#### **Cemetery Access**

A further meeting has taken place and Council unanimously agreed for the new access to be sited off the bridleway running along the rear of the Churchyard with a turning to be positioned between the Churchyard and Cemetery. Canon Grant to be informed of decision. Clerk to request a specification in writing prior to this being sent out for quotations.

### The Villages - (issues other than Traffic Calming and matters delegated to the GPC)

Edlesborough: Clerk to contact EDF Energy regarding position of light at Church End and to request that a longer

arm be attached to throw light onto the highway,

Edlesborough: Cutting down of ivy on trees on The Green to be carried out as soon as possible.

#### **Northall Councillor**

Information and request for a Councillor for Northall Ward to be distributed to each household in Northall.

## Local Area Forum

#### Terms of Reference (Standing Orders)

The meeting agreed that proportional representation be adopted for a trial period. A single Councillor would not have more than one vote so a Council that wished to use two or three votes had to have two or three representatives at the meeting.

#### Rights of Way

A presentation was given by Bucks CC Rights of Way officers outlining their activities and details of the Edlesborough-Ivinghoe Aston Bridleway upgrade were given. Edlesborough Parish Council were concerned that the remainder of the bridleway up to the High Street had not been covered and were informed that there was no further money left in this year's budget but when further funds are available this will be reviewed.

#### **Extended Services**

Details will be published in the minutes.

## Adult Social Care Surgery Update

The next surgery will be held at Yardley Avenue, Pitstone on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2009 and it is hoped to extend the service to the more rural communities using the mobile library facility.

# Transportation Issues

Bletchley Landfill have advised their customers that the M1 roadworks are now complete and asking them to use the M1 and A5 to access the site.

There are no changes to the winter salting routes this year.

Any problems regarding highway reinstatements within 2 years should be referred to Bucks CC.

## **Delegated Budget**

All the delegated budget bids are being collated and will be prioritised in the same way as they used to for Local Committees. The prioritised list will be taken to the March meeting for a decision.

### Other Business

It was proposed to hold a workshop to identify priorities based on common issues affecting parishes within the local

Community area to enable Bucks CC to incorporate into their plans. This to be further discussed at the March meeting commencing at 6.00pm instead of 6.30pm.

The Chairman of EDaN committee was requested to forward copies of the EDaN plan to both AVDC and Bucks County Council.
