Matters to Report to the Police

This item was brought forward on the Agenda to allow the PCSO to leave.

The PCSO reported that statements were currently being taken regarding the incident which occurred prior to a previous Parish Council Meeting. The Chairman expressed concern with the delay in dealing with this matter. The PCSO also reported that when reporting an incident parishioners were requested to phone 999 as reports to the 0845 8 505 505 number was not dealing with incidents as quickly as it should due to the locality. A joint meeting is being held between Thames Valley Police, Hertfordshire and Bedfordshire Police in an endeavour to have a more closer liason in dealing with incidents which occur on the boundaries of the three districts. It was felt by the Parish Council that the Neighbourhood Action Group meetings were not being run as efficiently as they should but it would be a lost opportunity if they stopped as they enable the Police and Parish Councils to come together to discuss relevant Police issues.

Parish Plan (EDaN Project)

Parish Council were concerned that parishioners were becoming confused between the work of the Parish Council and the EDaN Project. The EDaN Project consists of parishioners and one or two Councillors who have formed a Steering Group Committee to oversee the finalisation of a Parish Plan which will give a 'wish list' of what parishioners would like to see take place in their Parish over the next 5 to 10 years. This is a completely separate Committee to that of the Parish Council and in due course when final Parish Plan is produced the EDaN Project committee will present the Plan to the Parish Council for it to consider the 'wishes' contained therein. The Parish Council is pleased to see the progress being made by the EDaN Project through their Open Days held in Dagnall, Northall and Edlesborough with comments from parishioners.

Aylesbury Vale Local Committee

The next meeting will be held in July and Councillors were asked for items to be taken for discussion

Cluster Meeting Report

Council representatives had attended the recent meeting, which is held between Parish Councils and representatives from Buckinghamshire County Council. The national issue regarding radical ways of reducing traffic growth was discussed. Bucks CC will be preparing an HGV strategy involving routing traffic onto principal roads which at a local basis may include improvement to signage where appropriate or weight restrictions may be considered (referred to above under 'Villages'). The Council's request for re-location of the Speed Camera at Church End will be considered.

Currently the consultation for Area 13 of the Speed Limit Review will take place early 2009 with implementation Spring/Summer 2010. Bucks CC will investigate the Parish Council's report of bad condition of pot holes between the Beacon and Ivinghoe.
