On October 5th the Edlesborough Parish Neighbourhood Plan Referendum was held and Edlesborough Parish Council are pleased to share with all of you, the excellent result.

On a turnout of 45% of the electorate the result was 866 YES and 115 NO. A positive 88% in favour.



Thanks go to the entire council, the Core Team, the Steering Group and the Village Teams for putting the plan together and to the YES Campaign Team for their tireless efforts to get people to vote and vote YES.
