Match Day Parking Issues

EPC and EB Lions have been looking at ways to help alleviate the parking issues around The Green on match days. The following measures are now being implemented:

- EB Lions will place traffic cones on the High Street, Edlesborough at the junction with Cow Lane at the start of match days.
- Edlesborough Surgery have kindly consented to the club being allowed to use the surgery car park as an overflow car park on match days.
- EB Lions have contacted the families of all their members reminding them to park considerately; and refrain from parking on the pavements in the village and from blocking driveways and road junctions.
- EB Lions coaches will communicate clear parking instructions to all opposition teams when arranging fixtures.

The Council and EB Lions hope that these measures will help to alleviate the parking issues. Thames Valley Police are also aware of the issues and will be monitoring the situation and may issue tickets to vehicles causing obstruction.

Potholes, Road Issues & Rights of Way

At the time of writing this report Bucks CC have informed EPC that the following repairs are scheduled for the week commencing 15th January. These works were due to be completed in December however the adverse weather conditions delayed them. EPC will continue to monitor the situation.

- Damaged lighting at Dagnall Roundabout.
- Travellers Rest Roundabout including lack of bollards and poor & hazardous condition of traffic islands. EPC have been informed that there are plans to remove existing bollards on the islands and to paint the islands white, and to clear the vegetation from the traffic islands.
- Travellers Rest Bus Stop – winter landscaping works will be raised to clear the kerbing and hard standing at this stop.
