

New Pavilion Ground Breaking Ceremony

On Saturday 19th October 2019 at 11:30am Edlesborough Parish Council and Edlesborough Community Sports Club C.I.O. hosted a ground breaking ceremony on Edlesborough Village Green to mark the start of construction of the new pavilion.

The ceremony was attended by approximately 100 local people. Youngsters from the Parish representing the tennis, cricket and football clubs joined those from the community and local business to start digging the foundations. Before they took to the spades the project was blessed by the local vicar, Rev. Joy Cousans. A representative of the local Baptist Church, Alister King, was also in attendance.

The pavilion project involves demolishing the old and tired existing pavilion and replacing it with a custom designed building designed to enhance the enjoyment of the Green both for the sports clubs and the local community. The first phase is expected to be completed by spring 2020.
