Edlesborough Green

New Pavilion

Work continues to progress slowly on the New Pavilion, the site has remained open during the recent national lockdown caused by the COVID-19 Coronavirus pandemic, but with much reduced staffing levels. A revised schedule of works has been issued and it is anticipated that the building will be completed by the end of the year.

EPC continues to work very closely with the Edlesborough Community Sports Club (ECSC) charity who will manage this wonderful new facility. Full details of those eligible for membership will be published shortly by ECSC but certainly all Edlesborough parishioners will have free membership. Whether it can open when completed will depend on the COVID rules at the time.
