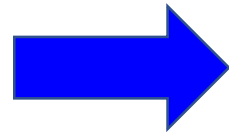

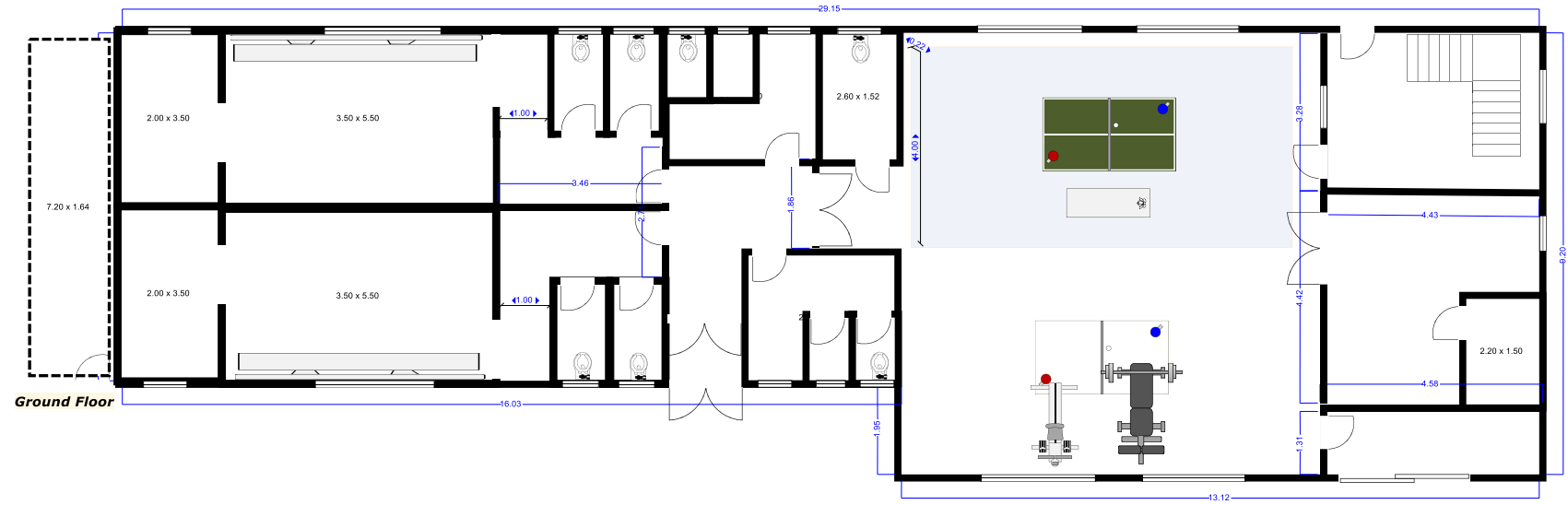

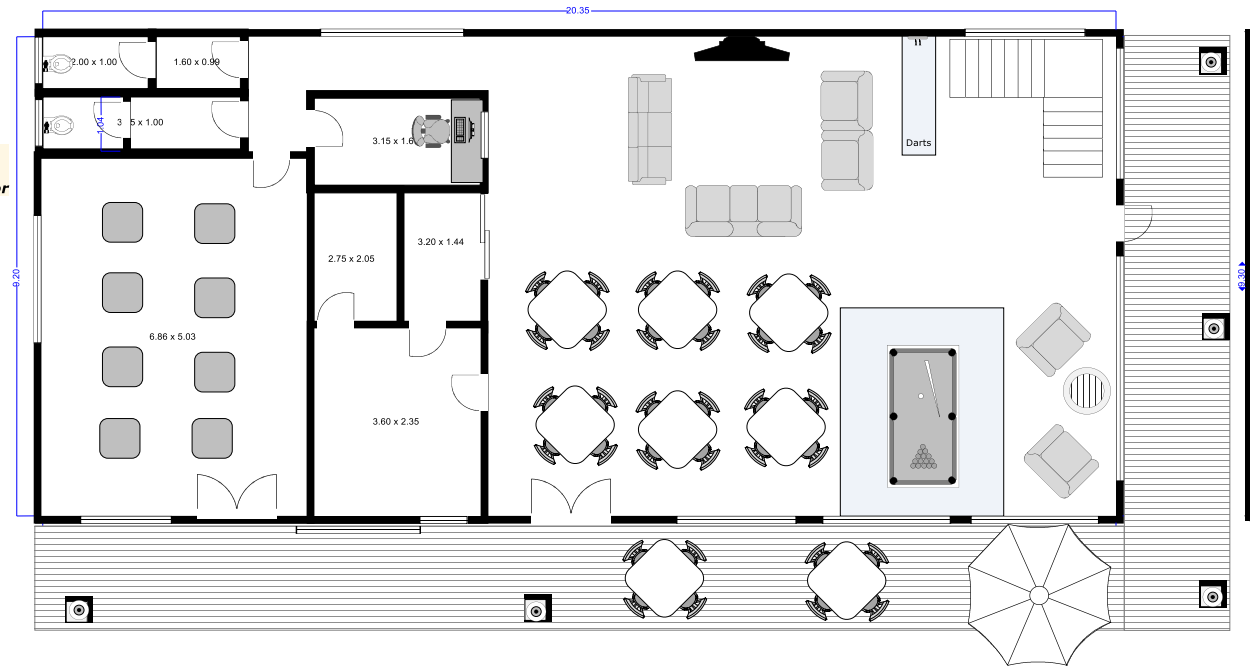
Report No 1

The Public Meeting, held in Edlesborough Memorial Hall on 13th June 2013 to discuss the future of Edlesborough Green and the Pavilion, attracted over 90 people. Following a series of presentations from the sports clubs, Sport England and social interests, everyone was invited to share their ideas and thoughts on the future. The result was a magnificent total of 110 yellow ‘post-it’ notes!

The meeting then went on to form a **Steering Group comprising of a representative from each of the existing 4 sports clubs, 5 parishioners (Mrs Gill Woodhouse; Mr Bryan Hammons; Mr Barrie Boon; Mr Ken Holloway and Mr John Howells), and 2 Parish Councillors.**

Extract from Report to EPC 12th March 2014

6. Recommendations and Required Decisions

6.1 The EPSG have listened to and recorded views from the wide range of consultations required by their remit and believe that there is substantial support from Parishioners and Sports Clubs to redevelop and replace the existing Pavilion with a more suitable building, encompassing community and sports usage.

They also believe that the needs expressed by the Parishioners and Sports Clubs are reasonable and worthwhile and that the project would enhance both local sport and the quality of life for many Parishioners, particularly the young, disabled and elderly.
