

F. How to use the power block to power or charge your device

Before you leave the Hall - PLEASE ensure that:

- 1. The TV is turned-off & the NVH Remote Control is returned to its holster.**
- 2. The NVH Radio Microphone is turned-off & returned to its holster.**
- 3. The NVH AUX 3.5mm cable is left neatly coiled on its hook.**
- 4. The NVH HDMI cable is left neatly coiled on its hook.**
- 5. The TV & Audio switches are turned-off. (There will be an unavoidable 'bang' when the Audio is switched off).**
- 6. The Power Block is turned-off (The blue light will be extinguished).**

A. How to Play music from your Phone, Laptop or iPad:

Using Blue Tooth (This is the most common way of connecting your phone)	
<p>1. Turn the input selector to BTooth/Tuner.</p> <p>Turn the volume switch to 5.</p>	
<p>2. Have your Phone/Laptop/iPad ready with Bluetooth settings.</p>	
<p>3. Switch on Audio socket only.</p>	
<p>4. Wait a few moments and view Bluetooth searches on your Phone/Laptop/iPad etc.</p>	
<p>5. Select the device PCR3000R on your phone.</p>	
<p>6. Your phone is now connected to the NVH Audio System & your music will play through the 4 Hall speakers.</p> <p>Use the Volume switch as appropriate.</p>	

A. How to Play music from your Phone, Laptop or iPad (contd)

Using AUX 3.5mm cable

(For Android Phones & all Laptops use the **BLACK** 3.5mm jack-to-jack AUX cable on the hook to the left of the Power Block).

(For iPhones & iPads use the **WHITE** Lightning cable on the hook to the left of the Power Block).

1. Turn the input selector to 3.5mm AUX.

Turn the volume switch to 5.



2. Connect one end of the AUX cable to your Phone/Laptop/iPad and the other end to the jack socket on the wall below the selector switch.



3. Switch on Audio socket only.



4. Your Phone/Laptop/iPad is now connected to the NVH Audio System & your music will play through the 4 Hall speakers.

Use the Volume switch as appropriate.





B. How to connect your Phone, Laptop or iPad to the TV & Audio system

(Screen sharing/mirroring/casting/streaming)

<p>1. Connect your Phone/Laptop/iPad to the NVH WiFi</p>	<p>NVH WiFi Name: BTB-FQCGKX</p> <p>NVH Password: H9eGnVc7hFXUbV</p>
<p>2. Turn the input selector to TV/Sound.</p> <p>Turn the volume switch to 5.</p>	
<p>3. Switch on TV and Audio sockets.</p>	
<p>4. Turn on the TV using the Remote Control.</p>	
<p>5. Press the Home button to ensure that you're starting from the same start-up position used in these Instructions.</p>	


Please go to Step 6 on the next page (page no. 5)

6. On your Phone/Laptop/iPad Settings - select screen mirroring (or, it might be something like Connection & sharing etc) and the **Wireless display will come up on Android Phones.**





On iPhones a 4-digit number will come up on the TV screen which has to be entered into the iPhone.

7. The TV will then show this message. Select 'Accept' by pressing the roller ball on the Remote control.



8. Northall Village Hall will appear on your Phone/Laptop/iPad & its screen will then appear on the TV.

Your device is now sharing its screen with the TV.



C. How to connect your Laptop to the TV & Audio system

The sound will be played through the 4 Hall speakers - not through the TV's built-in speakers).

Using HDMI to HDMI cable


(A HDMI cable is available on the hook to the left of the Power Block)

<p>1. Turn the input selector to TV/Sound.</p> <p>Turn the volume switch to 5.</p>	
<p>2. Switch on the TV and Audio sockets.</p>	
<p>3. Turn on the TV using the Remote Control.</p>	
<p>4. Press the Home button to ensure that you're starting from the same start-up position used in these Instructions.</p>	
<p>5. Connect one end of the HDMI cable to your Laptop and the other end to the HDMI socket on the wall below the selector switch</p>

C. How to connect a Laptop to the TV & Audio system (contd.)

6. This message should appear on TV screen:




If this message doesn't appear (or if you're not quick enough to select YES!): disconnect the HDMI cable from the Laptop and then reconnect – and the message will reappear.

7. Press the roller ball on the Remote Control to select YES.



8. Your Laptop will now be connected to NVH Audio Visual & TV system.



9. Use the Volume switch as appropriate.



D. How to just use the TV

(Northall Village Hall has a TV Licence)

(The sound will be played through the 4 Hall speakers - not through the TV's built-in speakers).

<p>1. Turn the input selector to TV/Sound.</p> <p>Turn the volume switch to 5.</p>	
<p>2. Switch on the TV and Audio sockets.</p>	
<p>3. Turn on the TV using the Remote Control.</p>	
<p>4. Select N using the roller ball on the Remote Control.</p>	
<p>5. Select the Home button.</p>

D. How to just use the TV (contd.)

<p>6. Point the cursor at the desired channel.</p>	
<p>7. Press the roller ball to select.</p> <p>8. Navigate to the desired programme using the outer ring (up/down/left/right)</p>	

E. How to use the radio Microphone

Using just the radio Microphone

1. Switch on the Audio socket only.



2. Turn on the Microphone by sliding the switch all the way to the top.



Please Note

*The Microphone volume is constant
and the setting of the Volume control has no impact.*

E. How to use the radio Microphone (contd.)

Using the radio Microphone at the same time as using the Audio or TV

1. Just turn on the Microphone by sliding the switch all the way to the top.



Please Note

In this operating mode, the sound of whatever is being broadcast will be lowered to allow the Microphone to be heard.

When you stop speaking into the Microphone the sound of the music or TV will automatically increase back to the original level.

The Microphone volume is constant and the setting of the Volume control has no impact.

F. How to use the power block to power or charge your device

The power block is located at the rear of the AV cabinet on the left.

Two 13A sockets on the left side.

Two USB charging ports.



1. Press the top button to switch on the power and the blue light will come on.

2. Plug your device into the 13A socket or plug the USB cable into the USB socket.



3. Press the top button to switch off power and the blue light will go out.
