# Role of a CFR

- Providing good quality CPR and Defibrillating in the first 3–5 mins of a SCA can produce a survival rate of 50–75% (Perkins 2015).

# Role of a CFR

- Respond to ambulance 999 calls in local community, providing emergency care prior to arrival of ambulance
- Assist frontline ambulance clinicians at scene
- Support families and friends whilst at scene
- Support communities with public access defibrillator & CPR familiarisation
- Support the SCAS Charity in fund raising to support ongoing CFR yearly costs and funding for equipment, promoting the SCAS Charity's aims.
- Attend local events and first aid events

# Equipment Carried

- Oxygen and masks
- Defibrillator
- Airway equipment to help clear and maintain airway
- Diagnostic equipment for BP, oxygen levels, temperature, blood sugar, pupil check
- Medicines including aspirin, glucose gel, Entonox (pain relief)
- Bandages, dressings and tourniquet
- Mobile phone for activation to job (with sat nav)
- Blanket
- Paperwork

# Cost of a CFR

Kit bag £2000

Defibrillator £1300

Annual upkit £350.00 which includes line rental for responding mobile phone, initial training and ongoing yearly update training, batterys/pads, equipment consumables , uniform.
