### Annual Parish Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting for Edlesborough, Dagnall and Northall will be held commence at 7.30pm on Thursday 22nd May in **Edlesborough Memorial Hall**.

This meeting offers any parishioners, organisations, and businesses in Edlesborough, Dagnall and Northall and local areas the opportunity to raise any issues. Unlike a normal Parish Council meeting, in this special meeting anyone is allowed to speak on any topic related to the parish.

All parishioners are encouraged to attend. By attending the meeting, you will get to meet representatives from organisations in the Parish and this may lead to opportunities to work together with them and or the council.

### Buckinghamshire Council Changes to Comment about Planning Applications

Until very recently, anyone wishing to make a comment about a planning application could do so on the Buckinghamshire Council (BC) website and that comment would be visible to all, including the personal information. From now on, whilst anyone can still comment, it will only be visible to the BC planning team and the Buckinghamshire Ward Councillors. This change is being made for data privacy reasons, and all that will be publicly visible is the number of comments made.

Edlesborough Parish Council is concerned that this change will make it harder for the Parish Council's response to planning applications to properly reflect the sentiments of the community we represent, as we will be unable to see any comments ourselves. We encourage parishioners to continue making comments on the BC website as before but please also email a copy of your comments to <u>clerk@edlesborough-pc.go.uk</u> so that we can give full consideration to them in our response.

Please note the time available to enter comments in Public Access expires quite quickly. To avoid losing long comments, consider typing them in a separate document (such as Word or Notepad) and then copying and pasting them into the comments page.

### Considerate Parking in the Villages

Once again the Council reminds parishioners to park considerately in the villages. Please do not park:

- on the pavements or grass verges.
- Opposite or withing 10m of junctions.
- Across resident's driveways.
- On the white lines or keep clear markings in the villages.

### Village Planters

**DO NOT** stop or park opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space.

## Grass & Hedge Cutting in the Villages

Now that the spring has arrived the cutting of the grass verges will resume. EPC reminds parishioners not to park on the grass verges as this causes damage to them and inconveniences the contractors.

EPC reminds all parishioners whose hedges border the pavements that they are required to ensure that their hedges are kept well-trimmed, ensuring that the maximum pavement width is available for pedestrians, pushchair, and wheelchair users.
