Thames Valley Police Update

PCSO Tina Hobson gave the following update on the main crime figures for January 2024 – mid May.

Cllr Booth went on to explain that the next projects are.

Cllr Williams explained that he has now been approved as the local Speedwatch Coordinator and will do all he can to get Speedwatch up and running in the near future.

Buckinghamshire Cllr Chris Poll

Cllr Poll praised Edlesborough Parish Council and commented on the important role it plays in local government.

He explained that 73% of Buckinghamshire Councils budget is now spent on Social Care and that budgets are tighter than ever.

Buckinghamshire Cllr Peter Brazier gave a brief summary of the history and purpose of the Community Boards, explaining that they are a vital link between Buckinghamshire Council and the Parish Councils.
