Edlesborough Parish Council does not have any jurisdiction over parking on the highway.

Annual Return 2024/25

The internal Audit of the Accounts for the year 2024/25 has been completed. The Council approved the Annual Return for the year ending March 2025 at the June 2025 Council meeting. The Accounts have now been submitted to the external auditor PKF Littlejohn LLP.

Council hereby gives Notice of Public Rights and Publication of Unaudited Annual Governance and Accountability Return for the Accounts for the year ended March 2025.

Any person interested has the right to inspect the accounting records for the financial year to which the audit relates. The documents will be available on reasonable notice by application to the Clerk. The inspection period is 30 working days, commencing 23rd June, and ending 1st August.

Buckinghamshire Council Changes to Comment about Planning Applications

Until very recently, anyone wishing to make a comment about a planning application could do so on the Buckinghamshire Council (BC) website and that comment would be visible to all, including the personal information. From now on, whilst anyone can still comment, comments will only be visible to the BC planning team. This change is being made for data privacy reasons, and all that will be publicly visible is the number of comments made.

Edlesborough Parish Council (EPC) and our Buckinghamshire Ward Councillors have raised their concern to Buckinghamshire Council that this change will make it harder for the ECPC's response to planning applications to properly reflect the sentiments of the community we represent, as we will be unable to see any comments ourselves.

EPC encourages parishioners to continue making comments on the BC website as before but please also email a copy of your comments to <u>clerk@edlesborough-pc.go.uk</u> so that EPC can give full consideration to them in our response.

Please note the time available to enter comments in Public Access expires quite quickly. To avoid losing long comments, consider typing them in a separate document (such as Word or Notepad) and then copying and pasting them into the comments page.
