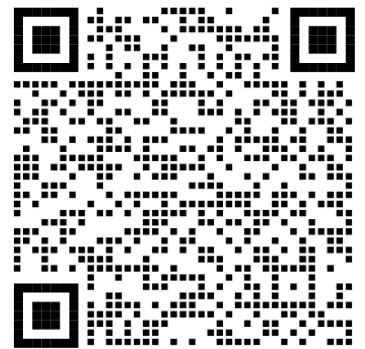




## CONSULTATION on Ivinghoe Freight Zone local access and permit holders restrictions.

Buckinghamshire Council would like to inform you that a consultation will be commencing on **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2025**, running for just over **4 weeks**, ending on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025**. The consultation is aimed at amending the existing Traffic Regulation Order to allow those requiring local access and permit holders to enter the current Ivinghoe Freight Zone. This change would create the basis on which we will be able to seek enforcement of the zonal restriction under the powers of Part VI of the Traffic Management Act (2004), known as Moving Traffic Offences.
