Re: Ivinghoe Freight Zone local access and permit holders restrictions

Edlesborough Parish Council submits the following comments in response to the Ivinghoe Freight Zone local Access and permit holders restrictions consultation.

It is very clear from the recent ANPR survey that the Freight Zone will only be effective if it is subject to enforcement. If the proposed amendment to the existing TRO, to allow permit holders to leave and re-enter the Zone without terminating their journey or making a delivery or collection within the Zone, is a prerequisite to Buckinghamshire Council gaining MTO enforcement authority, then Edlesborough PC supports the proposal.

However, Edlesborough Parish Council's support for the proposal is **conditional** on the Council being assured that enforcement will be implemented.

Without enforcement, the permit scheme would simply mean even more HGVs using the B440 through Edlesborough and Northall. In that case Edlesborough PC opposes the proposal.
