Thames Valley Police (TVP)

PCSO Tina Hobson attended the October Council meeting and provided the following crime figures for the Parish. The figures were from 1st September, so there is some overlap with the figures provided at the September Council meeting.

PCSO Hobson advised the Council that;

- inconsiderate parking that causes an obstruction should be reported to Thames Valley Police.
- anyone witnessing hare coursing should report it as a matter of urgency via 999.
- there has been an increase in tool thefts from vans. The perpetrators are becoming increasingly aggressive. Parishioners are strongly advised to remove all their tools from their vans and to report any suspicious activity or thefts to TVP.

Its focus will be on helping Town and Parish Councils and local organisations to complete projects and access funding from other sources.
