## Improvements to Edlesborough Memorial Hall

## Grass and Hedge Cutting in the Villages

The Council's contractor is scheduled to cut **The Pastures hedge** in the **last week of June or first week of July**. This timing is intended to ensure that the majority of nesting birds will have fledged.

This hedge borders **The Pastures estate**, along **The Green, Brownlow Avenue, and Pebblemoor**.

The Council recognises concerns regarding nesting birds and endeavours to take all reasonable steps to protect wildlife. However, the Council is also required to ensure that hedges do not overhang footpaths in a way that could:

1. Obstruct or endanger pedestrians; or
2. Create a potential hazard along the footpath.

Parishioners are reminded that **parking on grass verges is not permitted**, as this causes damage and hinders maintenance works.

Additionally, all residents whose hedges border pavements are reminded that it is their responsibility to keep them well trimmed, ensuring the **full width of the pavement** remains available for pedestrians, including pushchair and wheelchair users.
